Al Act (Proposed)

The EU approach to Artificial Intelligence centers on excellence and trust. People and business should be able to enjoy the benefits of AI while remaining safe.

The proposed legal framework would address the risks of AI and categorise them into 4 levels of risk (unacceptable, high, limited, or minimal risk).

The Digital Services Act Package

- The Digital Services Act (<u>DSA</u>) specifies rules regarding online intermediaries and platforms
- The Digital Markets Act (<u>DMA</u>) specifies rules that govern gatekeeper online platforms

Data Act

Regulation on harmonised rules on fair access to and use of data. The Data Act

- Allows user access to their own user-generated data
- Provides means for access and use of data for public interest purposes
- Simplifies switching between providers for users
